



ASTROLOGICAL ALARMS FOR TSUNAMI OCCURRENCE IN VIEW OF HUMAN WELFARE

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ABSTRACT:

Tsunami: is the word of Japanese origin. It means “a huge wave in the bay”. Science today recognizes Tsunami as long sea waves generated by the sources that are other than that of meteorological origin. Such as – Earthquakes, submarine volcanic eruptions, submarine & surface landslides and rock falls. Vulnerable areas for Tsunami occurrence are seashores having ports and infrastructure facilities. Most vulnerable areas are lowlands, steep bays, lagoons, estuaries, deltas etc. Vedic astrology has developed a method, few thousand years back in time, to time, the natural disasters occurring due to Earthquakes, Volcanic eruptions or Tsunamis that occur because of earthquakes deep inside the sea-bed. If this knowledge is applied properly we may time the events like Tsunami. These can be timed one year in advance. Vedic astrology considers The tides of Moon. It is an established fact that the high and low tides of the sea are controlled by waxing and waning phases of the moon. The peaks of the tides are during full moon(waxing) and new moon(waning). This phenomenon occurs due to gravitational force exerted by the moon, causing the tides to rise and fall. Astrological theory states one more thing that, more planets on either axis of the Moon or the Sun during such full or new moon, increases gravitational force and causes the tides to increase proportionately in the size. Maharshi Jaimini & Varahamira advocate certain sutras in their treatises. Based on these sutras that are given by them I have fixed 15 main things that one needs to study. Now these become the 15 rules of study. There is a main chart/horoscope for the event of Tsunami & special chart that deals with these disasters called Rudramsa divisional chart based on the main chart. Depending upon the number of rules that become applicable out of 15, 6 points per rule are given. This totals to 90 points. Percentage is calculated based on total score of points, out of total 90 points. Total 20 events have been analysed. 19 events out of 20 have shown a percentage more than 50% rules can be applied as has been suggested in the Vedic Astrology. This really is encouraging to pursue research in this direction in future. Ultimately based on these the final conclusion is drawn.

INTRODUCTION:

Indian Philosophy & traditional ancient sciences (Shastras) as well as Indian psyche which follows the Vedic tradition, considers Earth as “Mother Earth.” So, any kind of natural disasters occurring in the environment of Earth are considered as pains of mother Earth, arising out of an ailment. Just as we do study diseases and through consistent research-effort try to find solutions in the form of medicines for cure, a similar effort is made here to provide an advance warning with the help of science of “Vedic Astrology”, to the people residing in different societies, regions or countries in different parts of the earth. Vedic astrology has developed a method, few thousand years back in time, to time, the natural disasters occurring due to Earthquakes, Volcanic eruptions or Tsunamis that occur because of earthquakes deep inside the sea-bed. Present work is based on natural disaster – Tsunami. Tsunami: Is the word of Japanese origin. It means “a huge wave in the bay”. Patel (2005) , “ Planets play most important role during





natural disasters. he further quotes Varahamihira that: If during the event of full or new moon, Mars is either in Sagittarius, Pisces, Taurus or Scorpio, whilst Saturn is retrograde, a major calamity will hit the world and take many lives. According to BrihatSamhita, Varahamihira divides earthquakes into four types to judge the effects of these occurrences depending on the Nakshatra occupied by the Moon, during the event. Types of the earthquakes are: Vaayu(wind), Agni(fire), Indra and Varuna. All Nakshatras of moon are spread across these four groups. Amongst these groups the wind(Vaayu) group or Maruts cause the most wide spread devastation.

MATERIAL AND METHOD:

The Photo plates available on the sites are given for each event and was stored after giving a serial number like in the above, "TSU_Ex-1: Time: 15:36 UTC ." TSU stands for Tsunami. Ex-1 means Example number 1. Time: is the time of the occurrence of Tsunami happening mostly because of earthquakes or natural disaster in the water. Time can be UTC = Universal international time with reference to Greenwich Mean Time(GMT) or it can be local time whichever is made available in the plates. TSU_Ex-2: Time 05:20 to 05:21 is local time at Messina, Italy. These plates provide other information for the event such as Date, Magnitude in Mw, Epicentre shows the Co-ordinates in terms of Latitude & Longitude of the event. Countries or regions affected and number of deaths are shown as casualties. Casualties for TSU_Ex-1 are 1000 & for TSU_Ex-2 these are 200000. In the present work 20 different events defined by Date, Time and Place were considered which have occurred across the globe. Horoscopes for each event were prepared with





the help of Jagannath Hora (JHora), 7.65 version to study the natural disaster i.e. Tsunami. Effects of different planets and Nakshatras(Asterisms) were studied. –Divisional charts Rasi(D-1) and Rudramsa(D-11) were used to study the 20 events of Tsunami. MaharshiJaimini and Rudramsa: he advocates in one of his important Sutras that: In Rudramsa(D-11), when Mercury becomes evil, will cause destruction in the form of natural disasters such as earthquakes, landslides, flooding etc. The evil Rudramsa in particular are the 1st, 8th and 10th signs from Lagna/ascendant, in the RudramsaD-11) chart. This fine tuning should be analyzed in earthquake chart itself. *Conditions to be seen in Table: I – A & I - B If at the time of the earthquake the Moon's Nakshatra type(Mandala) & the Time(Vela) both are matching then the 100% result(Phalita) of the quake will be experienced. Here devastation/disaster will be on a very higher side. If both are not matching(Suppose Moon's Nakshatra is of Vaayu(Wind) type & Vela or the time duration is other than Vaayu i.e. these are different) then result is null & void. The quake will not produce expected result. That is the Nakshatra type is Vaayu-Mandala simultaneously if time is that of Indra-Vela or Vice-a-Versa or the Nakshatra type is Agni-Mandala simultaneously if time is that of Varuna-Vela or Vice-a-Versa then, the quake will not produce the expected result. 15 Rules were used to study the effects. Each rule carries 6 points. Maximum points that can be allotted per event are $15 \times 6 = 90$ points. In tables $Y = 6$ points per rule. These are seen in Table II. Tables: Table II: Shows 3 parts A, B, & C. Part A: Shows Rasi(D-1) & Observations showing Yes for "Y" are related to Figure I. [Total 4 Y for yes are possible. Maximum points here can be $Y=6 \times 4=24$.] Part B: Shows Rudramsa(D-11) & Observations showing Yes for "Y" are related to Figure II. [Total 8 Y for yes are possible. Maximum points here can be $Y=6 \times 8=48$.] Part C: relates to observations showing





Yes for “Y” are related to Nakshatra of Moon & is to seen with the help of Table : I – A & Table : I – B. [Total 3 Y for yes are possible. Maximum points here can be $Y=6*3=18$.] Table: III: Shows Grand total of Rasi(D-1) = [A] + Rudramsa(D-11) = [B] + Moon(Mo) = [C] is shown in the “TOTAL” column. %age points column shows percentage that is given for number of points given for corresponding event in “TOTAL’s” column. Last two column shows Magnitude in Mw showing intensity & number of deaths as casualties. In table -1 A Moon’s Nakshatra defining the four types of the earthquakes & Table-I B it is defining the Time(Vela) duration denoted for four types(Mandala) of earthquakes.

RESULT AND DISCUSSION:

Twenty horoscopes/charts were studied and the results were presented in Tables I, II and II. Figure I & II. Keeping all these different points in view, a table having three distinct parts was developed. The following table is filled in for 15 rules that are to be verified. Points are shown in the tabulation for this study table. Any one single event can have a maximum 90 points. Total 20 events of Tsunami are studied and conclusions are drawn accordingly. These points are given based on study of Rasi(D-1) & Rudramsa(D-11) charts/horoscope. Final tabulation table shows the magnitude of the event. Magnitude given in as Mw is a number that indicates the intensity of the event. Also the number of casualties is given. This shows number of dead people of that event of Tsunami. The magnitude & casualties number of event are not establishing any relation as such. Magnitude can be on the higher side, but the casualties number can be on the higher or lower, depending upon the area of the occurrence of Tsunami. If Tsunami occurs in a thickly populated area the casualties number is much on the higher side. The discussion shows results which have an achievement of 50% & above are definitely worthy to consider seriously.





CONCLUSION:

In Figure III graph shows 19 events out of 20 events have got more than 50%. Finally this means that the rules that are given to indicate destruction in the form of natural disasters such as earthquakes, landslides, flooding etc. are noteworthy & should be studied further. The study like this will help to predict such mass destructive events at least one year in advance.

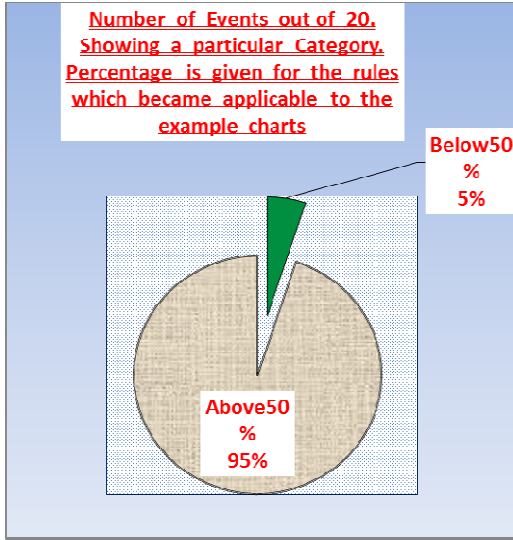


Figure 1:TSUNAMI_Ex-1 rasi(D-1) chart of 1906: (Ecuador)

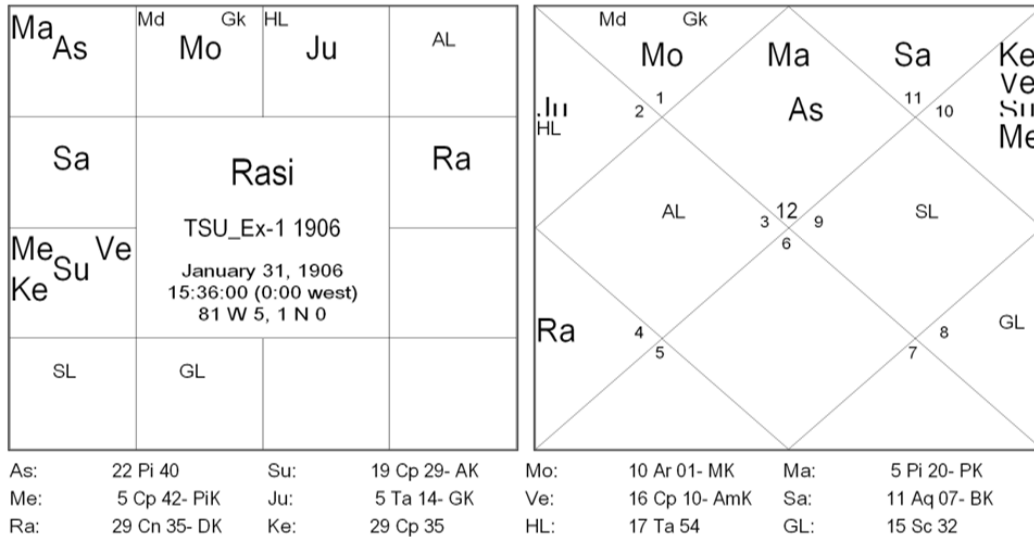


Figure II :TSUNAMI_Ex-1 Rudramsa(D-11) chart of 1906: (Ecuador)
